ATTENDANCE POLICY

A master absence record will be kept throughout the season to track all absences and their nature. Anything beyond 3 unexcused absences will be grounds for dismissal from the program.

Athletes are expected to attend practice even when injured. If an injury prevents active participation, a written doctor's note must be provided. It is important the athlete be present for any changes that may affect him/her.

If an athlete must miss practice, they are required to notify the Team Mom in writing or by text as soon as the absence is known so a substitute can fill their spot. We understand that serious illness, funerals, school events, and similar situations arise. Please use your 3 allowed absences wisely.

ABSOLUTELY NO ABSENCES ARE ALLOWED:

- The week before competition
- On competition day(s)
- During choreography camps or team events

Coaches reserve the right to replace an athlete who misses practice the week before a competition. If a competition is missed for any reason, the athlete will not receive any gifts (medals, jackets, etc.) unless approved by staff.

Please submit all planned vacations and absences in writing by July 15th, 2026.

Athletes who arrive more than 5 minutes late or leave more than 5 minutes early will be considered Tardy. 5 Tardies = 1 Absence.

BEHAVIOR & SOCIAL MEDIA

All athletes and parents are expected to promote friendship through support, encouragement, and respect. As representatives of 910 Wolf Pack, showing respect and good sportsmanship toward coaching staff, other teams, organizations, and hosting venues is always expected.

Negativity, gossip, or hostility toward any athlete, staff member, or parent will not be tolerated and can be grounds for immediate dismissal. Any individual observed verbally assaulting or threatening a team, coach, parent, or athlete will be addressed and/or asked to leave immediately or probationary status. Continued behavior issues will result in the athlete's removal from the program and ineligibility to return the following year.

No athlete or parent may post inappropriate content on any social media platform (Facebook, Twitter/X, Instagram, Fierce Boards, group chats, etc.) about another program, individual, or 910 Staff or Program information. Prohibited content includes, but is not limited to:

- Sexual or nude photos
- Photos depicting drug or alcohol use (actual or implied)
- Photos showing inappropriate or vulgar gestures or innuendo

Team videos may not be posted publicly on any social media platform or website without prior permission from the Coaches and Gym Owner. All choreography — dances, stunts, and music — is proprietary and should be strictly protected.

Bullying of any kind, whether in person or via social media, texts, or group chats, will result in immediate dismissal.

COMMUNICATION

Parents are responsible for regularly checking the Band app, emails, and the website for the most current information about the program, schedule, and events. Being uninformed is not an acceptable excuse when information has been provided through official channels.

Any program information communicated should be considered confidential to 910 Wolf Pack program members only, unless explicitly stated otherwise.

Athletes are not permitted to contact coaching staff directly through texts or social media platforms. An open forum for athletes is the only approved channel.

We adhere to the 24-Hour Rule: if you are upset or concerned about something that occurred at practice, tumbling, or a competition, please wait 24 hours before contacting your Team Mom or Coach. Reacting when emotions are high is rarely productive. All parties — athletes, staff, and parents — are expected to observe this rule.

DISCIPLINE

If any Program Expectations or Codes of Conduct are compromised, the following progressive action will occur:

- 1st Violation – Meeting with the athlete and/or parent defining the problem
- 2nd Violation – Meeting with the athlete and the parent(s)
- 3rd Violation – The athlete may be removed from the team or program. No refunds will be given.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

A schedule of fees and payment due dates is included in this handbook. Parents and/or responsible adult parties will be asked to sign an acknowledgement of Financial Policies for the 2026–2027 season and are responsible for maintaining their athlete account(s) in good standing.

All athletes must maintain a debit or credit card on file in the GoMotion software system. Payment of all tuition and program fees will be made via automatic bank draft if not paid prior to the due date and will incur a 3.9% processing fee through the merchant (unless previously approved by the Business Manager or Gym Owner).

Monthly tuition fees are due and will be drafted on the 15th of each month. Monthly fees are not prorated for any reason.

A late fee of \$30.00 will be assessed for any payments made more than three (3) calendar days past the due date. Failure to meet payment deadlines without reasonable communication will result in loss of services and/or dismissal. Coaches reserve the right to replace the athlete if this occurs. No exceptions.

If your account is delinquent by more than 10 calendar days, 910 TumblingAcro, LLC reserves the right to:

- Withhold services (e.g., private lessons, classes, etc.)
- Withhold uniforms
- Withhold Pro Shop in-house or preorder purchases
- Withhold team and/or individual pictures

All travel reservations, accommodations, and plans are the sole responsibility of the athlete and family, unless otherwise noted by 910 Tumbling Acro, LLC. 910 TumblingAcro, LLC is not responsible for reimbursing travel expenses in the event of unforeseen event cancellations, loss of skills, injury, or athlete removal from the program.

All competitions are subject to change, and all monies are NON-REFUNDABLE unless an event is cancelled by the Event Producer (EP) due to COVID-19 state restrictions or a similar circumstance. If a competition is cancelled by 910 Wolf Pack, every effort will be made to replace it with a comparable event.

FUNDRAISING

All fundraising efforts are optional. However, athletes with delinquent accounts may be asked to participate in fundraisers until their account is brought current.

910 Wolf Pack is one of the few programs that allows families to keep 100% of their fundraising profit to use as they wish — tuition, fees, private lessons, or travel expenses. Funds are not automatically applied to your account.

The only exception is when a fundraiser results in a company check made out to the gym. In such cases, families will be notified of the situation and timeline prior to the fundraiser so they can decide whether to participate.

PRACTICES

Practices may be changed or added at any time during the season with proper notice. If practice is cancelled, make-up practices may or may not be added at the discretion of the Coach and Gym Owner.

Practice attire is required at all designated practices. Parents are welcome in the building but must remain in the upper viewing area. For safety reasons, lobby guests may NOT communicate with athletes or coaches on the gym floor at any time. Any attempt to communicate via yelling, waving, whistling, clapping, etc. will result in being asked to leave immediately.

Coaches may occasionally invite parent participation (cheering, scoresheets, etc.) and we appreciate your spirit within those boundaries. Coaches reserve the right to close practices at any time for any reason.

Facility Rules:

- No gum, food, candy, or sodas in the gym area — only water and Gatorade
- Trash must be disposed of in appropriate receptacles; bathrooms must be kept neat
- Athlete cell phones must be turned off and put away during practice
- 910 Wolf Pack assumes NO responsibility for lost or damaged personal items

Program Withdrawal or Dismissal: Should an athlete choose to leave the program at any time after August 1, 2026 and prior to the end of the season, written notice is required and a \$500 Re-Choreography Fee will be drafted from your account on the day notice is received. If no written withdrawal is received, the account will continue to be charged through the end of the season.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are designed and produced exclusively for our program. Fitting dates and times will be announced in August. Athletes are expected to keep all uniforms in good condition. The cost of replacement will be charged to the athlete should the uniform be lost or damaged.

COMPETITIONS

Late arrivals to a competition will incur a \$25.00 fee. When traveling to competitions — whether staying locally or traveling — please allow adequate time for arrival.

The Final Competition Schedule will be in place by August 31, 2026. A mandatory parent meeting will be scheduled prior to Showcase to review expectations and answer questions.

FINAL ROSTERS

Final rosters will be announced no later than August 31, 2026. If your athlete is practicing with two teams over the summer and you do not wish for your athlete to cross over, please be aware that when rosters are finalized, Coaches will place each child in the position best suited for both the team and the athlete's success. Placement decisions are at the Coaches discretion, not by choice of the athlete or parent.
